

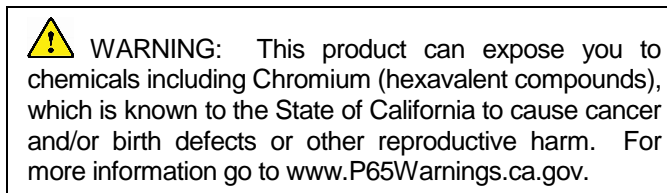

Subject: **California Proposition 65**

California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, better known as Proposition 65, was enacted to protect the state's drinking water sources from chemicals that are known by the state to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. Proposition 65 also requires that businesses and / or manufacturers provide a clear warning before exposing anyone to chemicals that are on the list that is maintained on the California government website: <https://oehha.ca.gov/proposition-65>

Maintainer provides products that include many parts and optional components that may or may not contain certain chemicals listed on the California list of chemicals that are known to the state to cause cancer or reproductive harm. Maintainer has chosen to include a label on their products as shown below. This label represents one of the more common chemicals that may be included in metal products and, at the appropriate exposure level, are known by the state of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm.



SPECIAL NOTES:

- *Particularly when purchasing a complete vehicle, other Proposition 65 warning labels may be included in the full assembly from component vendors regarding their specific products, like the chassis manufacturer.*
- *If the part or assembly being sold is too small for this label, the box and/or packaging will include the label.*
